JUNIOR NPL BAY OF PLENTY PLAYING CONDITIONS 2017/18:

- Each team consists of 6 players on the field at once. Teams may rotate players if they have more than 6 but only 6 players will bat each game.
- Each game consists of one innings per team. An innings should take no more than half an hour and a game should take no more than one hour.
- Each innings is played over 12 overs so every player bowls two overs each.
- Each over will comprise of six balls only. No extras will be re-bowled.
- The umpire can move the bowler up the pitch if this makes it easier for them to get the ball down the other end.
- A ball will be deemed a wide if it is off the pitch or realistically out of reach of the batter.
- A ball will be deemed a no ball if it rolls along the ground and the batter cannot or chooses not to physically hit it.
- A ball will be deemed a no ball if it is over shoulder height on the full.
- In all situations if a wide or no ball is bowled then 2 runs will be awarded to the batting team.
- All overs are to be bowled from one end.
- There are NO boundaries (ALL runs must be run)
- Batters bat in pairs and each pair bats for 4 overs. For every wicket lost three runs are deducted from the score.
- Each team automatically starts on 200 runs and the team with the highest total at the end of the game shall be the winner.
- Batters can only be dismissed by being bowled, caught or run out. There shall be NO LBWs or stumpings.
- Batters change ends if they are out bowled or caught.

Umpires: use your discretion to make this as enjoyable as possible by adapting / adjusting rules so that players get a good hit!!!!

E.g. If one batter is facing more balls than the other, then swap them round so they face an even amount of balls within their pair.
